Cassadaga Book Club - Is taking a break for the summer. We will be meeting again September 24th, 2022.

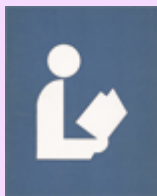

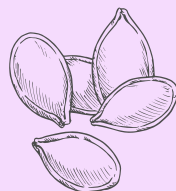

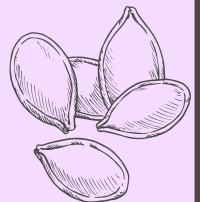
